New Registrant Position

Community Midwives of Hamilton is seeking a second New Registrant (NR) for a 2025-2026 contract position with a late-fall/early-winter start date. It is a minimum one-year contract position, with strong potential for extension. We are a busy urban teaching practice that offers diverse and unique opportunities for your NR year.

We offer a positive, supportive, and flexible work environment with different models of care, including primary and shared call. Initial caseload is booked for successful applicants by the practice group, with NRs starting clinic 12 weeks prior to first caseload. NRs are required to be on call for six weeks prior to first caseload in order to facilitate orientation to our clinic, community, and hospitals. NRs are paired with an assigned mentor from the practice group for their first year. The mentor provides one-to-one support during orientation, is available for ongoing questions or concerns, and conducts regular reviews during your transition to a General Registrant.

Our practice maintains active privileges at both Hamilton Health Sciences (HHS) and St. Joseph's Healthcare Hamilton (SJHH). Hamilton is an excellent location for an NR to develop and practice to their full scope in a supportive environment. HHS offers the benefits of a Midwifery Care Unit. Officially opened in 2022, this unit offers midwives the opportunity to continue to support and develop alternative models of care in our community.

Hamilton is home to a diverse population, and our clinic has developed several community partnerships to provide accessible midwifery care. This gives NRs the opportunity to work with clients with diverse needs. We currently have midwives who provide care in Arabic, French and Spanish.

Hamilton and the surrounding areas offer beautiful green spaces - including renowned waterfalls, parks, and hiking trails; alongside a vibrant and re-emerging downtown core complete with various cultural experiences - food, theatre and a thriving art scene.

We are seeking a dedicated team member who is innovative and passionate about the care they provide. We welcome candidates with experience working with clients of diverse backgrounds.
