Hearst Midwifery Practice is a solo practice located in Hearst, a small northern town of approximately 5,000 people. It also serves Kapuskasing (100km east) a town of approximately 9,000 people and the First Nations' community of Constance Lake. Both Hearst and Kapuskasing are mostly francophone therefore being bilingual is a great asset.

Privileges are held at Notre Dame Hospital, a level 1 hospital with c/section capabilities, in Hearst. The midwife works closely with the nursing staff and the 2 family physicians that provide OB care in Hearst and also with OB providers in Kapuskasing (for clients that choose to deliver there). At Notre-Dame hospital, the midwife practices under a full scope of practice i.e. inductions, augmentations and epidural management. In the case of a c/section, the midwife fills the baby nurse role and provides initial care for baby.

Caseloads vary monthly, therefore there is flexibility to take time off during less busier times.

Due to the large catchment area, a lot of hours are spent on the road therefore the midwife must enjoy driving and must do so in various conditions.

Hearst and its surroundings offer plenty of outdoors activities during all seasons of the year. There are plenty of lakes to enjoy fishing and other water sports during the summer. Winter months can be spent cross country skiing a few minutes away and plenty of snowmobiling trails. Hearst also has a very vibrant arts scene that offer many (usually francophone) plays, shows and arts exhibits just to name a few.
