## **General Registrant LOCUM – August 2019**

We are eagerly looking for a General Registrant locum for the month of August 2019. We are a very busy two-midwife practice in a small community in Northwestern Ontario, and one of our RMs is taking her annual leave for the month of August so we need a locum to cover her prenatal and postpartum visits. There is also the option to attend deliveries in the role of the back-up midwife, although we have a second attendant arrangement with the hospital so that is only obligatory for home deliveries. Depending on numbers, there may be an available course of care but compensation will likely be in the form of the AOM block incentive fee.

Kenora Midwives is a busy rural/remote practice serving Kenora and the surrounding area. We currently have privileges at Lake of the Woods District Hospital and have a strong working relationship with the hospital, physicians and nurses. We work with full scope of practice; epidurals are not offered, and we do not transfer care for inductions. There are no Obstetricians in Kenora so we work closely with 6 family physicians, with whom we have an excellent relationship. We refer our high-risk clients to Obstetricians in Winnipeg, Manitoba when necessary.

For the outdoor enthusiast, our community lies within the heart of Central Canada's Lake of the Woods region. This area offers fishing, hunting, hiking, cycling and boating, beautiful beaches, and small-town hospitality. Our population is about 15,000 in the off season with those numbers tripling in the summer months. We are located 222 km north of the Canada/USA border, 200 km east of Winnipeg and 560 km west of Thunder Bay Ontario on beautiful Lake of the Woods.
