## Midland Midwives is looking for a ¾ time General Registrant for September 2018

Midland Midwives is looking for a ¾ time (30 BCC) General Registrant Midwife for a 12 month contract with the possibility of extension or permanency. Hospital privileges are at Georgian Bay General Hospital (Midland) and Orillia Soldiers' Memorial Hospital, our Level II referral centre.

Midwives Nottawasaga was established in 2008 and began offering clinic in Midland in 2012. In 2017, we created an official satellite clinic in Midland within the Chigamik Community Health Centre. We share the goal of providing exceptional and culturally safe care for the large Indigenous and Francophone populations of the area. As such, priority will be given to applicants who are Indigenous, and those with French language fluency.

Located on traditional Wendat territory, this area is home to Indigenous peoples with a variety of cultural backgrounds, primarily Anishinaabe and Haudenosaunee. Centred in CSC Chigamik CHC, Midland Midwives Nottawasaga benefits from their long-established relationships with the local Indigenous community and aims to provide a supportive work environment for Indigenous care providers. In addition, we are conducting a needs assessment for an Indigenous Midwifery Program in the 2018-2019 fiscal year.

We are seeking someone with a passion for rural midwifery combined with an understanding of the importance of dedicated team work, community outreach and creating a presence in an underserved area.

We work in a shared call model, with regularly scheduled time off and 3 months vacation annually. Payment will be by billable course of care with due dates beginning in September. The successful candidate will be encouraged to participate in community outreach to increase caseload.
