## General Registrant Position Available Half-time position (min 20 BCCs) starting in September 2018

Midwives of Georgian Bay is looking for a General Registrant Midwife to join our practice with due dates starting in the Fall, 2018. We are a small practice with full-scope privileges at West Parry Sound Health Centre (Level I) and restricted scope privileges at Orillia Soldiers' Memorial Hospital (Level II). Our practice has been serving Parry Sound and the surrounding communities since late 2013, and is well integrated in our community, with strong interprofessional relationships at both hospitals. We have alternate practice arrangements approved by the CMO for nurses to provide back-up at WPSHC and for second attendants to attend home births.

It is our goal to have 3 midwives who work part-time, billing a minimum of 20 BCC's, and 16 weeks holiday per year. This would enable two midwives to be available and one midwife to be off. Currently, two midwives rotate every 1 or 2 weeks between primary on-call or primary in clinic. The clinic midwife is also available as second on-call in the event of simultaneous births, sleep relief, attending in the role of second midwife for births at OSMH, and additional support when requested by the primary on-call midwife.

We are located on Anishinabek and Robinson-Huron treaty territory. Our catchment area includes five First Nations' communities: Wasauksing, Moose Deer Point, Shawanaga, Magnetawan, and Henvey Inlet. We provide care for clients who live up to 90km south, east, and north of Parry Sound. We are strongly committed to providing culturally skilled, quality care that is grounded in compassion, informed choice and continuity of care. We support clients' choice of birthplace, and currently have a home birth rate of 18%.

We value an atmosphere of mutual respect, support and equity. We are committed to constructive communication, personal responsibility, and social change. As a small practice, administrative tasks are shared, and there is a continuing need for outreach activities. We see this position as an ongoing position with the potential for partnership in 2-3 years, subject to mutual agreement.

Applicants will ideally have current General Registration with the CMO, a minimum of 3 years' experience as a midwife, knowledge and experience providing full-scope midwifery care, a passion for providing midwifery care in a small community, strong interpersonal skills, and winter tires. Midwives will ideally live within 30 minutes of Parry Sound. Indigenous applicants are encouraged to apply.
