North Channel Midwifery is currently a solo midwife practice looking to expand due to client demand. Care is heavily community based and focused on developing strong relationships with clients and colleagues. We service a large, beautiful catchment area along the North Channel of Lake Huron, from Thessalon to Massey, including Sagamok Anishnabek. We are a rural practice working in full scope primary care and we attend all births with 2<sup>nd</sup> Attendants. We have a varied clientele, which also includes Amish, Old Order Mennonite, and Indigenous people. All client appointments are done in clients' homes and often involve other family members.

We are committed to providing client-centric, respectful, and high-quality care, while embracing these values: humility, respect, caring and supportive mentorship.

We are looking for someone who enjoys rural communities, embraces our values, has experience working full scope, and at a level 1 hospital (a level 2 hospital is 2 hours away). The incumbent must be comfortable with driving longer distances (up to 200 km a day), and sometimes during inclement weather. Expectations also include participating in obstetrical hospital rounds, participation in community events, and community outreach.

Limited off call time is balanced by working with clients who have realistic expectations of your availability. Holidays and time off will be planned collectively within the practice to ensure quality time away from work.
