Boreal Midwifery Practice (BMP) is in Timmins, a remote city in Northern Ontario serving a wide catchment area including Cochrane, Iroquois Falls, Val Gagné, Matheson, Ramore, and Foleyet. Since 2007, our well-established practice has provided care to this diverse community, currently supported by four full-time midwives. We serve clients from a range of backgrounds, including Old Order Mennonite, Indigenous, and Francophone communities.

Our midwives hold privileges at the Timmins and District Hospital with a level 2a NICU, working within a full-scope model that includes managing oxytocin and epidurals. We are well supported by nurses and obstetricians and transfer care to obstetricians for high-risk cases. Pediatricians are on-call 24/7.

We proudly support choice of birthplace, with 30% of our births occurring outside the hospital—whether at home or in our clinic. We also have a satellite clinic located at the Matheson hospital where we conduct prenatal and postpartum care for the growing Old Order Mennonite population.

Our practice prioritizes work-life balance with flexible scheduling and protected time off call. We offer 24/7 support for our New Registrants and offer regular check-ins to ensure your success for continued learning.
