General Registrant Position

Community Midwives of Hamilton (CMOH) is seeking one General Registrant (GR) for a negotiable winter start date (January to March 2023 preferred). It is a minimum 1 year, contract position, with a strong potential to extend. CMOH has a clear path to partnership for all midwives who remain at the practice. We are a busy urban teaching practice that offers diverse and unique opportunities for you.

We offer a positive, supportive, and flexible work environment with different models of care, including primary and shared call. The current position will be to work in the primary call model. Primary call offers every second weekend off call from Thursday evening until Monday morning. Midwives also have 2-3 vacation months every year.

Our practice has privileges at Hamilton Health Sciences (HHS) and St. Joseph's Hospital Hamilton (SJHH). Hamilton is an excellent location for a GR to practice to their full scope in a supportive environment. HHS recently opened a Midwifery Care Unit (MCU). This is an excellent opportunity to develop and grow an innovative midwifery governed, model of care. Hamilton has a very diverse population, and our clinic has partnered with Urban Core Community Health Centre, Compass Community Health, and the Francophone Health Centre as well as receiving referrals from other community organizations. This gives GRs a well-rounded exposure to serving a variety of clients with diverse needs. We have midwives who provide care in Arabic, French and Spanish.

Our practice has strong inter-professional relationships, holding positions on many hospital, AOM and CMO committees. New GRs will receive orientation and support to clinic, community, and hospital standards. They will also have a mentor assigned to help with their transition to practice at CMOH.

We are a busy teaching practice. GRs have the opportunity be involved with first year midwifery student experiences and medical student observations, including student workshops. You are likely to be involved in the supervision and preceptorship of NC and senior students. There are also many opportunities be involved with the McMaster Midwifery Education Program teaching sessions.

Hamilton and surrounding area offer green space, waterfalls, parks, and hiking trails alongside a vibrant and re-emerging downtown core complete with a variety of cultural experiences - food, theatre, and a thriving art scene.
