### **One Full Time Permanent Midwife is being recruited for the Highland Community Midwifery Team**

The Nova Scotia Midwifery program was established in April 2009. It currently comprises of three sites: one urban and two rural. The two rural sites are the South Shore Community Midwives based in Lunenburg, and the Highland Community Midwives based in Antigonish.

As a result of recent investment in the Midwifery service we are creating teams of three Midwives who will ensure the ongoing sustainability of the practice in their local communities.

We are now hiring for a permanent full time Registered Midwife for the Highland Community Midwifery Team in Antigonish.

The Highland Community Midwives are employed by the Nova Scotia Health Authority and are well respected members of the local maternity care team. The Midwives have established excellent collaborative relationships with nurses, obstetricians, family physicians and nurse practitioners in the area. The teams are small, but cohesive and mutually supportive, both in our hospitals and in the local communities.

The Highland Community Midwives provide primary care midwifery in the Canadian model. Each Midwife has a case load of around three – four clients per month, has privileges at St Martha's Regional Hospital in Antigonish. Home births are also offered for Mothers who meet the low risk criteria. They enjoy serving a diverse clientele throughout the Eastern region.

The Highland Community Midwives community clinics are located in Guysborough, Port Hawkesbury and Antigonish.

Antigonish, the "Highland Heart of Nova Scotia", is a small university town in a rural community, close to many beautiful parks and beaches– close enough that you can enjoy them even while on call! There is a strong sense of community in the town and county, with a busy farmers market, vibrant art/music



scene and plenty of family-friendly activities throughout the year. Antigonish is located approximately two hours away from the city of Halifax.
