



Kawartha Community Midwives is seeking one associate position (NR or GR) starting September 2026, with the possibility of a permanent position based on fit and functionality within the practice. The position is for a shared care caseload of 34- 40 BCCs per year.

The ideal candidate will demonstrate a commitment to anti-racism, equity, and ongoing professional development.

As a group, we strive to create a supportive environment and value creativity and growth within our practice. We hold Schedule Q funding, which allows us to care for unattached newborns in our community for the first six weeks postpartum.

KCM serves a diverse population across both urban and rural settings. Our team includes both newer and highly experienced midwives. We are privileged to work with Peterborough Regional Health Centre, a hospital environment that fosters positive interprofessional collaboration across disciplines.

We currently manage epidurals and anticipate adding oxytocin within the next year; comfort with full scope is considered an asset. Approximately 30% of our births are out of hospital, and we offer the option of birthing in our clinic's birth suite.

At Kawartha Community Midwives, we are deeply committed to supporting practice members to thrive — not just as midwives, but as human beings. We provide 10 hours of sleep relief to midwives who have been up overnight and complete the sleeping midwife's home visits so they are not waking up to multiple pending visits.

Peterborough-Nogojwanong is a community rich with opportunity. The young population continues to grow, and the community is thriving alongside that growth. Our downtown offers excellent coffee, vibrant farmers' markets, and diverse restaurants. We are surrounded by lakes, rivers, and parks for those who enjoy outdoor living. Our queer community is strong and well supported. Arts and culture are valued and easily accessible. The city is socially and environmentally progressive while remaining an affordable place to live.
