Midland is a unique corner of Ontario. We are nestled on the south shore of Georgian Bay in beautiful natural surroundings, about 1.5 hours from Toronto. Our midwife group is deeply integrated into our Level 1B hospital. We make up >50% of the obstetric care providers and provide care for over 50% of our community's births.

We are seeking candidates with a passion for rural midwifery combined with an understanding of the importance of dedicated teamwork, community outreach, and creating a presence in an underserved area. This is a young and growing practice, aiming to foster a culture of strong support for the midwifery team. This means commitment to mentorship of new team members and students, policies supporting sleep relief and leaves of absence, and flexibility in response to midwives' desires for caseload and call structure. We're not perfect, but we're sticking together through this healthcare HR crisis!

Full time position:

- 36 BCC in a shared call team with 12 weeks of vacation
- Some flexibility to adjust call rota to suit individual needs
- Start date as soon as possible (ideally Fall 2026)
- Contract for 1 year, possibility of long term & partnership for the right fit

Part time/casual position:

- Somewhat open-ended, we have room for a midwife who wants to work part-time to support weekends and holiday coverage.
- Pay is structured similarly to AOM locum program with a daily rate, but is paid for by the practice.
- May be suitable for someone living outside of catchment who is willing to travel.
- May also suit someone who wants to work a slower-paced low-caseload midwifery model in a gorgeous beach town.
