



## THE MIDWIVES OF ALGOMA

Midwives of Algoma are looking for a GENERAL REGISTRANT to join our team.

Our ideal applicant is someone who genuinely enjoys midwifery, works to expand their knowledge base and skills, appreciates the value of teamwork and is committed to achieving work-life balance for themselves and in supporting their teammates to do so.

Our clinic is in the Superior Health Building in downtown Sault Ste. Marie. We are currently a practice of 5 full time midwives with a new registrant joining us in mid-June. We are looking for someone to start in November, with an established full-time caseload. However, we are flexible and could accommodate sooner if necessary. We work in a primary call model in teams of two with each midwife having every other weekend off call Friday-Sunday with generous, flexible additional time off throughout the year including protected sick time.

Scope of practice includes induction/augmentation without consult and epidural with privileges at Sault Area Hospital. We enjoy a positive and fully integrated relationship with our hospital and have an especially good relationship with the nurses and OBs on our unit. Because we are a small northern practice, with limited human resources, we are a true team, and we are looking for a midwife who values their colleagues in that way.

Working in Sault Ste. Marie, you will be supported in participating in opportunities for continuing education. The Midwives of Algoma were the first in Canada to first assist in cesarean sections. We continue to assist at the majority of c-sections in our city and would support an applicant in completing this training prior to or after joining the practice should they wish to do so. We also have a midwife in training to place IUDs, midwives who have done locums in Nunavik and Nunavut, and midwives who are pursuing other continuing education programs.

We feel strongly that for midwifery to be sustainable, it is important to have supportive call partners, regular time off call, support for unexpected illness, family emergencies and important personal events, and support to pursue midwifery and non-midwifery related passions and adventures.

Sault Ste. Marie is located near beautiful Lake Superior, with many beaches and camping spots nearby and countless hiking, biking and skiing trails in the city and surrounding area. Housing is affordable and we are only a one-hour flight from Toronto, making travel during time off accessible.
