We are looking for a full-time Registered Midwife to join our postpartum focused team. This position is a sustainable way to work as an RM, offering true work-life balance. We have a growing caseload of postpartum-only midwifery clients and robust referrals.

Postpartum focused midwifery provides care to clients not typically reached by midwifery care, primarily those seen by other maternity providers, and clients with complex medical and social histories. Postpartum focused midwifery is dynamic, interesting, and challenging, with the benefit of most of the work being done during the day with little, if any, overnight work.

We value work-life wellness and are very flexible to create a supportive schedule allowing for balance and time off. Depending on your interest, there is also the option within this team to provide full midwifery care to a few clients per month.

Strathcona Midwifery Collective is a well-established practice located at the convergence of the Downtown Eastside, Strathcona & Chinatown neighbourhoods of Vancouver, on the unceded and ancestral territories of the xʷməθkʷəy̓əm, Skwx_wú7mesh, and

Səlilwətaʔ/Selilwitulh Nations. We care for a diverse clientele and offer inclusive care which affirms the dignity of the families we serve. Some of the specific communities we are privileged to care for are the LGBTQIAS community, Indigenous families, and newcomers to Canada, many of whom are undocumented and have precarious status in our health care system. We strive to be a safe, accessible, and welcoming clinic and we are always learning from our clients and from each other along the way.

Our recently renovated clinic is situated in a vibrant Chinatown block with cafes, restaurants, and a bookstore. There is a small community pharmacy on the ground floor, that is keen to support our clients. We are well positioned close to major transit hubs and a bike route and are a few blocks from the future St Paul's hospital site.

We have excellent full-time administrative support, and we use Oscar EMR for all our charting.

We hold privileges at BC Women's and St. Paul's Hospital.
