We are looking for a General Registrant to fill a unique position in a shared call model of care. On-call time is shared between the two partners, with the majority of your on-call time occurring at night. Your daytime hours would be very predictable: protected off-call time with some scheduled clinic and visits. This two person team acts as one midwife, supported by the primary call midwives in the practice. You would have ample time off call and vacation time (10-12 weeks). You would bill 30 courses of care in a year, with some flexibility in that number.

Countryside Midwives is a rural practice, surrounded by beautiful countryside with various urban settings close by. Lake Huron is also just a short drive away, perfect for all those off-call days! There are many organic farms that sell to the public, and many of our Amish and Mennonite clients sell produce right at the source.

This position is situated out of the Milverton clinic, with Stratford, Kitchener and Waterloo a short drive away. We cover a large rural catchment area, and enjoy a high home-birth rate, and a low intervention rate. We work out of 3 hospitals, Stratford, Listowel and Fergus, with the majority of hospital births at the first two. We do manage epidurals at all 3 sites, and while we transfer care for inductions, we do enjoy a low transfer rate overall, as many of our clients are highly motivated to have a normal birth. We see many of our clients in their homes antenatally, and many of our booked clients are multiparous.

The ideal candidate should have an interest in rural midwifery, feel comfortable with homebirth, and either have experience with alternative remedies or wish to learn more!
