



Midwifery Consultant - AI in Clinical Practice Project

The AOM is seeking a midwife to lead a short-term consulting project exploring the integration of artificial intelligence tools in midwifery care settings. This is an exciting opportunity to shape guidance for midwives who may be exploring how to employ AI in clinical practice.

The project has two core deliverables:

1. **AI Clinical Decision-Making Guidance:** Develop a practical, accessible resource outlining key considerations for midwives when using AI tools to support clinical decision-making. This will involve a scan and synthesis of existing guidelines, frameworks, and evidence relating to the use of AI tools in clinical decision-making, with recommendations relevant to midwifery practice.
2. **AI Scribe Adoption Resource:** Review and curate existing resources to help midwives and practice settings think about whether adopting an AI scribe is right for them. This includes identifying frameworks or checklists and synthesizing them into something useful and relevant for a midwifery audience.

Who We're Looking For

The ideal candidate is a midwife with experience in research, quality improvement, knowledge translation, and/or health policy. Familiarity with digital health tools or an interest in health technology is an asset. Strong written communication and the ability to synthesize evidence and resources into practical, clinician-facing outputs are essential.

Please describe your experience curating or synthesizing resources for a clinical audience. What formats or approaches would you consider for delivering these outputs and how would you ensure they reflect the realities of midwifery practice?
- 4. Workplan:** Include a brief high-level plan describing how you would approach the work and allocate the available hours across the two deliverables.
