We have a back-up contingency on-call system which is relied upon a few times per year when all on-call midwives are unavailable due to simultaneous work duties or illness.

We are located in the GTA - 30 mins from downtown Toronto and Hamilton - our midwives have resided in areas surrounding our catchment such as Oakville, Rexdale, and West Toronto. Our practice serves a growing and diverse population including many new immigrant/refugee families and those without OHIP.
