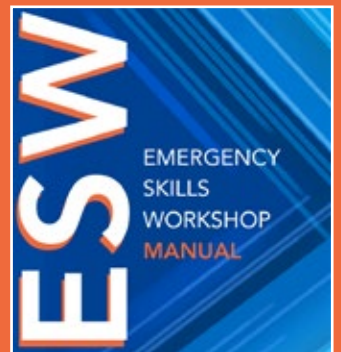


On November 1st, 2024, the AOM launched the 8th edition of the Emergency Skills Workshop (ESW) manual.
