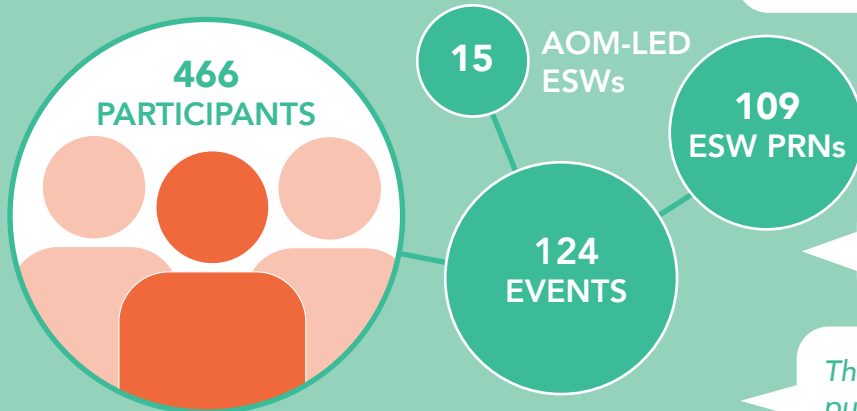


In 2023, the AOM expanded the ESW PRN program to **all midwives across the province**, making ESW recertification more accessible.

Through **ESW PRN**, midwives request an ESW event in their community directly from an instructor. Almost two-thirds of midwives (62%) recertifying in the AOM's ESW program in 2023, chose to recertify in their communities through ESW PRN.

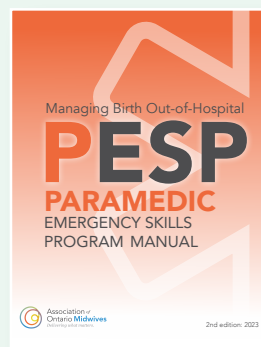
