



## **Locum General Registrant: 2 Positions**

**7 month contract at 34 BCC, starting October-November  
12 month contract at 24 BCC, starting November-January  
With Possible Extension**

Come join us! Family Midwifery Care is seeking 2 General Registrant midwives.

Position 1: The 7-month position is to start in October or November for a minimum of 7 months with a caseload of 34 on a 3-midwife pod following a rotation with regular time off.

Position 2: The 12-month position is to start as early as November and as late as January. It will be on a 3-midwife pod designed to give longer periods of time off at a time (2-3 months) to support other endeavours such as work overseas or in the North.

We are actively seeking candidates who have varied personal and professional experiences. Candidates who speak multiple languages would be an asset. Guelph has many newcomers to Canada including a large community from Eritrea. We value a diverse work team that reflects the communities we serve. Midwives that identify as BIPOC are encouraged to apply.

We are a well-established practice of 14 midwives working in a shared care model. In this model midwives work in primary care teams of two or three midwives. This allows us the satisfaction of getting to know our clients well, while at the same time having a generous amount of off call time. We aim to be a supportive, fair and flexible group where both full and part time midwives.

Our charting is done with an EMR (Accuro). We hold privileges at Guelph General Hospital (Level II) where we have good interprofessional relationships and are actively working on adding oxytocin to our hospital scope.

We serve a diverse group of families in Guelph, Fergus and surrounding areas including some Mennonite and other rural communities.

Guelph is a vibrant university community with abundant outdoor activities, agriculture, arts and academics.
