Come join us! Family Midwifery Care (FMC) is seeking a New Registrant midwife to start in September 2021 with possible extension. This position will have a caseload of 32-35 BCC/year in a pod of 3 midwives. The ideal candidate has interest and skills in serving clients who experience barriers to care as we develop an exciting outreach partnership with multiple community agencies.

We value diversity within our team and recognize the benefits for our practice and the clients we serve. We are actively seeking IBPOC candidates, and we are working earnestly to make our team and practice more inclusive. The ability to provide care in languages other than English is an asset.

FMC is a well-established practice of 14 midwives. We work in a shared care model with 5 teams of 2 or 3 midwives with both full and part-time caseloads. The primary team model allows us the satisfaction of getting to know our clients well, while offering generous off call time. We aim to have long term midwives join our partnership and we strive to be a supportive, fair and flexible group that values collective decision making. We use Accuro EMR and ISP computer hospital charting.

We hold privileges at Guelph General Hospital (Level II) where we have good interprofessional relationships. We maintain care of clients with epidural and we are actively working on adding oxytocin to our scope.
