



General Registrant Locum Position

Grand Valley Midwives is a semi-rural practice seeking an experienced General Registrant for a locum position funded through the AOM locum program.

We have clinics in Grand Valley, Fergus and Mount Forest. The practice covers a primarily rural area, and includes several Mennonite communities who require prenatal home visits. We use an EMR (OSCAR) for charting, and have excellent administrative support.

Our Hospitals

We attend most of our hospital births at Groves Memorial Community Hospital, a Level 1+ hospital which has about 480 births/year. Obstetric, family physician and anaesthetic back-up are available 24/7. Epidurals are obtained by consulting directly with an anaesthetist; oxytocin inductions or augmentations require a transfer of care. We attend the occasional birth at Louise Marshall Hospital in Mount Forest, which is a small rural hospital suitable for low-risk births.

The Position

We are looking for a midwife to work on-call shifts, preferably 48-72 hours of call per week from April 2019-Mar 2020, however there is plenty of room for flexibility in the call arrangements. The locum midwife would be paid \$200.00/day by the AOM Locum Program to be on-call and would also be paid for any 2nds attended at home and hospital births. The locum would not be expected to attend primary births or scheduled clinic although they may need to, on rare occasions, do an urgent assessment or postpartum visit.

Alternatively, if a locum wanted to work for longer periods of time (minimum of a few consecutive weeks), the locum could be assigned caseload to bill during that time if they preferred.

This position would be ideal for a midwife who needs free time while on-call to work on a Masters or other project while still earning an income.

The AOM locum program provides funding to cover accommodation costs.
