Midwives provide primary care throughout pregnancy, birth and six weeks postpartum. We provide choice of birth place at Brockville General Hospital and in client's homes.

Every birth (home and hospital) is attended by two health care providers - a registered midwife and either a nurse (RHCP) or another midwife.

We are looking for a RN or RHCP with labour and birth or paediatric experience (ideally) who will be on call for home births in our catchment area. The responsibilities of a "second attendant" include monitoring vital signs, charting, checking fetal heart tones, providing comfort measures, assisting midwives, participating in neonatal resuscitation, preventative care and managing emergencies under the supervision and with the support of the registered midwife. Second attendants are required to have a vehicle and a valid driver's license.

The role of second attendant is a unique opportunity for someone who thrives when they have the time and focus to attend to one patient/client at a time. The successful candidate will contribute to and follow safety protocols but escape heavy bureaucracy, red tape and triple charting so common in our health care system. Our second attendant is beloved by the families they serve and makes a difference in the lives of those they serve every time they show up. Our second attendant is highly valued by the midwives and considered a key member of the team.
