



Midwifery Services of Haliburton - Bancroft

We are currently looking for a general registrant to join our growing practice. This would be a 1-year contract with an opportunity for longer contract. The start date is somewhat flexible however we are hoping mid-June.

We have been providing care to our rural community since 2008 and have seen significant growth in caseload over the past few years. Our catchment area is extensive and rural/remote. We have hospital privileges at Peterborough Regional Health Services which is 100km+ away from our primary clinic site and out of our catchment area. As a midwife of this practice, you will be expected to drive A LOT! The traffic however is exceptionally light, and the scenery makes it all so worth it.

We are very dedicated to our communities and the families we provide care to. We are also very dedicated to each other and understand that in order to provide care to clients we must also ensure we provide care to each other and strive to create a supportive environment for everyone. We currently work in a 4-week rotation being 1st on call, 2nd on call, in clinic, and off call. We provide shared care to all clients. There is also an opportunity to have 3 consecutive weeks off over the summer months. The clinic midwife also has the weekend off during the clinic week.

We are hoping to connect with a midwife that would appreciate why we work here and willing to join our team to help share the extra caseload and demands and benefits of our rural life. We currently have a waiting list over the summer months and are anxious to bring all those awaiting into care.

The successful candidate must be experienced and extremely comfortable in a homebirth situation (planned or unplanned) in a remote/rural location and working with a second attendant. We do have a 20-30 % home birth rate. They must also have a strong work ethic and be willing to step in if required to cover unexpected urgent off call requirements of colleagues. They must have excellent interpersonal and communication skills and must be willing to participate in outreach and non-clinical responsibilities of practice.
