Kawartha Community Midwives are seeking a General Registrant to join our team. This is a one-year contract to start, with the potential for a long-term position depending on fit, caseload and funding. This position would be in a shared call model with one week of call alternating with one week of clinic/off call. Caseload would be approximately 30 BCCs per year. We offer 9 weeks of vacation per year. We would like the successful candidate to begin clinic in June, with EDBs starting in July 2019.

Our practice strives toward a positive, collaborative and respectful work environment. We are a group of 8 midwives with a variety of midwifery backgrounds (pre-legislation, MEP and IMPP), and we value the perspectives and contributions that this variety brings. The expectation is that all member of the practice will eventually become partners. We have two support staff who keep the clinic running smoothly. Our clinic is located in a beautiful Victorian house in downtown Peterborough, walking distance to a farmer's market, many restaurants and riverfront trails. We are well integrated at Peterborough Regional Health Centre and enjoy positive working relationships with physicians and nurses. We are currently required to transfer care when our clients require oxytocin and epidurals, however we are working towards changing this in the future. We strongly value out of hospital birth, and offer a birth room in our clinic for clients who want an out of hospital birth and feel their home is not ideal due to distance from hospital or other factors. We serve a diverse community, which includes clients from a wide variety of socioeconomic backgrounds, LGBTQ+ families and First Nations communities. We especially encourage applications from midwives who reflect the diversity of the communities we serve.

Peterborough is a beautiful small city with access to a great variety of restaurants, art and culture as well as outdoor living, trails, rivers and lakes, and lots of local farms supplying our many farmer's markets. The cost of living here remains fairly affordable. Our catchment area extends about 45 minutes in all directions from Peterborough.
