## **NEW REGISTRANT POSITION**

We are excited to be offering a New Registrant position at Midwives of Georgian Bay. We can be flexible with the start date, subject to approval of Ministry funding. We are looking forward to providing support and mentoring to a New Registrant who wants to work in a small community with clients from a variety of backgrounds. We have had positive feedback from 3<sup>rd</sup> year students who have had placements here.

We are a small practice with full-scope privileges at West Parry Sound Health Centre (Level IB) and restricted scope privileges for oxytocin at Orillia Soldiers' Memorial Hospital (Level II). Our practice has been serving Parry Sound and the surrounding communities for 10 years, and is well-integrated into our community, with good inter-professional relationships at both hospitals. We also have medical directives at WPSHC to enable us to have an expanded scope of lab tests and medication prescribing authority.

We are currently 2 midwives who work in a primary call model with 11-12 weeks holiday per year in addition to regular weekends off. We are able to offer an ongoing GR position following the NR year, if the NR and MGB midwives want to continue to work together. We also are seeking an additional GR midwife.

We are located on Anishinaabek and Robinson-Huron treaty territory. Our catchment area includes five First Nations' communities: Wasauksing, Moose Deer Point, Shawanaga, Magnetawan, and Henvey Inlet. We provide care for clients who live up to one hour's drive north, east, and south of Parry Sound. We are strongly committed to providing culturally sensitive, quality care that is grounded in compassion, informed choice and continuity of care. Sometimes the care we provide can be logistically and clinically challenging. We have a home birth rate of 12-20% and increasing.

We value an atmosphere of mutual respect, support and equity. As a small practice, midwifery administrative tasks are shared, and there is an ongoing need for outreach activities. We have administrative support 2.5 days/week. We welcome applications from NRs with varied personal and professional experience, including Indigenous midwives and others who are prepared to actively engage in reconciliation action with our practice and local communities.

Applicants will need to be eligible for New Registrant status with the College of Midwives of Ontario and have experience (or a commitment to) providing full-scope midwifery care, a passion for providing midwifery care in a small community, strong interpersonal and communication skills, and winter tires.

Midwives will ideally live within 30 minutes of Parry Sound. This area is a UNESCO Biosphere, Georgian Bay Mnidoo Gamii Biosphere, with a strong arts community and a wealth of summer and winter recreational activities.
