The Midland Midwives are seeking a general registrant for a **one-year locum position**. Start date is ideally April 2024, but flexible. This position can be a **part-time or full-time contract position** with the potential for permanency. We are currently comprised of 3 teams in different call models. We are hiring for multiple positions and are able to offer some flexibility based on midwife's preference for primary or shared call. **Priority will be given to applicants who are Indigenous, and/or those with French language fluency.**

ABOUT OUR PRACTICE

The Midland Midwives are based out of our local Community Health Centre, and prioritize service for socially disadvantaged families. We aim to provide exceptional and culturally safe care for the region's large Indigenous and Francophone populations. The successful candidate will demonstrate a commitment to reducing barriers to health for clients with complex social and health histories. We are committed to client empowerment through social support, education, and informed choice.

We maintain a home birth rate of approximately 20%. We hold privileges at Georgian Bay General Hospital (Midland: Level 1A). We manage epidurals and

transfer care for oxytocin. We enjoy very positive relationships within the hospital and an excellent reputation within the community.

We are seeking someone with a passion for **rural midwifery** combined with an understanding of the importance of dedicated team work, community outreach and creating a presence in an undeserved area. This is a young and growing practice, aiming to foster a culture of strong support for the midwifery team. This means commitment to our policies around sleep relief and emergency leaves, flexibility in midwives' desires for caseload and call structure, and mentoring each other.

We live on the beautiful shores of Georgian Bay. The region is traditional Wendat and Anishinabe territory, and is currently home to a large and diverse community of Indigenous peoples.
