General Registrant Position Available (minimum 22-24 BCCs/year)

Midwives of Georgian Bay is looking for a General Registrant midwife to join our practice. We can be flexible with the start date.

We are a small practice with full-scope privileges at West Parry Sound Health Centre (Level I) and restricted scope privileges for oxytocin at Orillia Soldiers' Memorial Hospital (Level II). Our practice has been serving Parry Sound and the surrounding communities since late 2013, and is well-integrated into our community, with good inter-professional relationships at both hospitals. We work with nurses to provide back-up at WPSHC and second attendants at home births. We also have medical directives at WPSHC to enable us to have an expanded scope of lab tests and medication prescribing authority.

We are 4 midwives who all carry a lower caseload, billing a minimum of 22-24 BCCs/CVs per year. We are committed to equity in billing. We currently work in a primary call model with 13 weeks holiday per year in addition to regular weekends off.

We are located on Anishinabek and Robinson-Huron treaty territory. Our catchment area includes five First Nations' communities: Wasauksing, Moose Deer Point, Shawanaga, Magnetawan, and Henvey Inlet. We provide care for clients who live up to one hour's drive north, east, and south of Parry Sound. We are strongly committed to providing culturally sensitive, quality care that is grounded in compassion, informed choice and continuity of care. Sometimes the care we provide can be logistically and clinically challenging. We have a home birth rate of 12-20%.

We value an atmosphere of mutual respect, support and equity. As a small practice, midwifery administrative tasks are shared, and there is an ongoing need for outreach activities. We have administrative support 2.5 days/week. We welcome applications from midwives with varied personal and professional experience, including Indigenous midwives and others who are prepared to actively engage in reconciliation action with our practice and local communities.

Applicants will ideally have current General Registration with the CMO, a minimum of 2 years' experience working as a midwife, knowledge and experience (or a commitment to) providing full-scope midwifery care, a passion for providing midwifery care in a small community, strong interpersonal and communication skills, and winter tires.

Midwives will ideally live within 30 minutes of Parry Sound. This area is a UNESCO Biosphere, Georgian Bay Mnidoo Gamii Biosphere, with a strong arts community and a wealth of summer and winter recreational activities.
