Maternity Care Midwives are seeking a new registrant to join our diverse practice of 6 midwives! Thunder Bay is a thriving city surrounded by wilderness. Want to mountain bike, hike, swim or cross-country ski? You can do that all within call distance. Our practice works in teams of three, or a shared-care model. We strongly support work/life balance. Call schedule includes rarely being 1st on call for no longer than 48 hours, and while doing clinic not being 1st on-call unless covering for sleep relief. We also have a strict sleep relief policy if being up through the night a midwife will relief you. We provide our NRs with a supportive, continuous mentorship program.

We work in a mixed urban and rural setting being privileged to care for diverse populations including refugees and indigenous women and their families. We are a teaching practice for midwifery students, IMPP students, Northern School of Medicine residents as well a nursing students. We also provide a outreach clinic in Nipigon, an hour outside of Thunder Bay working in collaboration with family doctors in the community.

Midwives working in Thunder Bay hold privileges at Thunder Bay Regional Health Sciences Centre which is a tertiary level teaching hospital. As a midwife working at TBRHSC you will become a member of the midwifery department within the hospital in which we hold monthly meetings. We enjoy positive inter-professional relationships and are caring for approximately 30% of the childbearing population in the community.
