The overarching function of this position is to promote the quality and consistency of culturally safe midwifery practice and programming that contributes to the achievement of optimal maternal/child health outcomes in the NWT.

A position is currently available in Yellowknife, Northwest Territories, with consideration available to live and work in another NWT community currently delivering midwifery services

Typically this position requires successful completion of a Baccalaureate degree in Midwifery (Health Sciences), or assessed through a Prior Learning and Experience Assessment (PLEA) program within a Canadian province, with a minimum of 3 years' experience in delivering midwifery care as a primary care provider.

Experience in a midwifery leadership role would be an asset
