We are a supportive group practice working in a shared-call model. We hold privileges at Grand River Hospital, a Level-2 site, where we care for clients with low-risk labours and maintain care for epidurals. We are currently expanding our scope to include oxytocin management. Our practice members have strong interprofessional relationships and hold positions on hospital, AOM, and CMO committees.

We provide services to a mix of urban and rural clients and have a sizable Mennonite population. We enjoy our home births and offer nitrous oxide at home. We have a brand new birth suite for out-of-hospital deliveries as well.

Kitchener-Waterloo is a vibrant city, with several surrounding small towns. There are two universities, a college, a lively downtown, and many parks, trails and rivers for outdoor activities.

Start date will be January 1, 2024 for a minimum of 18 months. There is the possibility of extension for the right candidate. You will be working in a team of 2 or 3 midwives, with generous time off. Caseload is flexible between 25-36 BCCs/year.
