- **Thames Valley Midwives** is a mixed urban-rural practice situated in a beautifully restored heritage building in Old East Village, London. Our clinic uses Accuro EMR and has a fantastic admin team.
- **Our catchment area** is committed to providing exceptional care to a wide variety of groups, which include a largely ethnically diverse population with plenty of newcomers, as well as Old Order Amish, low-German Mennonite and First Nations populations in our rural regions. We offer our clients two satellite clinics in Elgin and Oxford. Our wait list is extensive. We also love home birth, with around a 22% home birth rate.
- **Our hospitals** - We are a full-scope practice, which has privileges at both a Level 1 and Level 3 hospital with supportive staff at each site and our own Midwifery Department. Other opportunities include an Early Pregnancy Discharge Program, where some of our midwives enjoy doing postpartum home visits for our OB colleagues!
- Our practice provides an exceptional **mentorship** program for you to thrive and grow in a nurturing environment. You will have access to 24/7 support from your team who are experienced in ongoing teaching in your first year as a new midwife including oxytocin and epidural supervision.

- We are a large group of supportive midwives looking for a **full time new registrant** based on funding approval, who enjoys working within a three-person shared care model of a rotational 6 weeks shared on-call and clinic rotation, followed by 3 weeks of vacation (total 17 weeks vacation). - We have an excellent call schedule offering every other weekend off (3 day long weekend), no more than 3 days on-call at a time, protected clinic hours and evenings during the weekdays off, with opportunities for other models within our teams based on availability.
- Caseload will be based on start date following privilege approval.
