Our Team & Clinic

We are a collegial team of five experienced full-time midwives seeking a sixth member to replace a valued colleague returning to her home community.

Our practice is grounded in fairness, transparency, mutual respect, and shared decision-making. We foster a collaborative, supportive environment and are looking for someone who thrives in a team-based model.

Our clinic operates on a cost-recovery model — we do not profit from one another's work. Each midwife contributes to practice operations, receives their full overhead payment, and benefits from low clinic fees.

Our Shared Space

We work in a spacious, welcoming clinic alongside:

- A trauma-informed, EMDR-trained Clinical Counsellor
- A Pelvic Floor Physiotherapist
- An Obstetrician

We are supported by:

- Five experienced independent RNs who assist with client care and help prevent midwife burnout
 - A highly skilled MOA with over seven years of experience supporting our team
 - OpenOSP/Oscar EMR with Cortico for secure client communication

Practice Model

We provide primary midwifery care to approximately 35 low-risk clients per month, offering both home and hospital birth. Home births include maternity RN backup.

Postpartum home visits are primarily conducted by our team of Maternity- and IBCLC-trained RNs, who also assist with occasional postpartum clinics. We have successfully supported home birth numbers for new registrants in recent years.

Schedule & Flexibility

Our six-midwife shared-care model offers significant flexibility and work-life balance:

- 5–6 x 24-hour call shifts per month
- 4–5 clinic days per month
- Extended vacation opportunities
- No clinic responsibilities while on call

On-call midwives manage births, hospital assessments, and pages. Clinic days are free from call responsibilities, allowing you to set your pace.

Hospital & Interdisciplinary Relationships

Chilliwack General Hospital (CGH) is a Level 1 hospital with 24-hour off-site OB and Pediatric coverage.

- Four community Obstetricians provide consultative care only (no primary care overlap)
- No NICU on site; we aim to attend births ≥ 37 weeks
- No maternity closures or unit diversions in the past three years
- Access to an on-call rest room on the maternity unit

We enjoy strong, collegial relationships with consultants and nursing staff. Since 2024, we have provided first assist for scheduled and emergency cesarean sections, further strengthening our collaborative presence.

Many hospital RNs also work with our practice providing home birth backup and community visits, creating continuity and strong professional rapport.

- A primary care GP/RM team
- The Chilliwack Obstetric Group (COGs)
- Midwife participation in MOCAP hospital call coverage

MOCAP call participation is available to team members after six months of on-call experience within our practice.
