The Mobile Midwife Clinic of Ottawa (MMC) is an innovative population-based model of Midwifery service provision that aims to address urgent and ever-increasing gaps in perinatal, newborn, and sexual reproductive healthcare (SRH) for those facing significant access barriers. The program prioritizes the hardest-to-reach clients who are experiencing the following access barriers: homelessness, uninsured/undocumented, fleeing Intimate Partner Violence (IPV), young/single. Many of MMC's clients are newcomers/refugees and we prioritize late-to-prenatal care intakes at any gestational age, as well as those that are medically high risk.

MMC works in a collaborative shared care model with OB (and MFM as required) at The Ottawa Hospital General Campus. The collaboration is supported by Dr Glenn Posner who enables Lead Midwife Sarah Beckman to provide an extensive range of SRH services including safe abortion care and drop-in SRH clinics.

Midwifery care is provided in shelters, homes, and neutral locations (parks, Tim Horton's, etc.) while facilitating prompt assessment, triage, and referral to Dr Posner when a higher level of care is needed, including intrapartum care at TOH General Campus.

MMC is also bolstered by referrals streams including Ottawa Public Health, Planned Parenthood Ottawa, Access Line (Action Canada), City Housing Workers/IPV shelters.

We are seeking a part-time GR (20 BCC/fiscal year) who values providing community-based perinatal care that focuses on priority populations. The successful candidate would have a passion for providing early pregnancy loss care, safe abortion care, contraception, STI testing and treatment, and shared care of high risk prenatal and postpartum clients.

- Intrapartum call/care is limited, most work hours are completed during the day
- Knowledge of a second language is an asset (French language skills in particular).
